About Annalea:

Hola! My name is Annalea Deems. I will be teaching the Beginners Spanish class. I am in my senior year of high school and enjoy learning the Spanish language. I have taken three years of high school level Spanish class from the La Clase Divertida® Spanish Program. Last year I had the opportunity to be a teacher's assistant (and substitute) for half of a semester. I have found through other experiences as well, that I love teaching. I have been able to teach some children's Sunday school classes and also some athletic academics. The goal of the Beginners Spanish class will be to have taught your student conversational Spanish and different phrases. The age that your student is at now is the best age to begin learning a new language! My hope is to instruct students in a way that they will remember these useful phrases and words for years to come.

Class Description:

Beginner's Spanish Class is an interactive class for students who are new to the Spanish language. Using teacher instruction, games, activities, and practice we will walk through 12 weeks of class with the end goal of learning beginner level phrases and conversational Spanish. A class tuition fee will be charged of \$25 per student for the semester. There will be two classes; one will be for students ages 6-8 and a second class for students ages 9-11. The material will be the same for both classes, but still tailored to your student's age range. No grades will be given; however, worksheets will be sent out for the students to complete at home. These assignments will not be required, but highly recommended. They will keep the material more fresh in the student's mind, as we are only meeting once a week. It can also help make the classes more fruitful for your student. I am so very excited for this semester to learn and have fun alongside your student!
